

## *atp6v0c*<sup>*hi1207Tg*</sup>

### Nature of the mutation

*hi1207Tg* constitutes a retrovirus-induced mutation:

### Genotyping assay

The forward primer (**Hi1207\_3E02**) anneals to the 3'-portion of the retrovirus that causes the mutation, and the reverse primer (**Hi1207\_3E01**) anneals to the adjacent genomic region flanking the virus.

#### **Primers:**

**Hi1207\_3E01:** 5' TGT GCC GTG ATG GAA ACC TTC 3'

**Hi1207\_3E02:** 5' TTC GCT TCT CGC TTC TGT TCG 3'

#### **PCR program (62\_40\_40):**

- 1\_94°C for 3 min
- 2\_94°C for 30 s
- 3\_62°C for 40 s
- 4\_72°C for 40 s
- 5\_Go to step 2 (above) for 34 cycles
- 6\_72°C for 5 min
- 7\_8.0°C hold
- 8\_END

#### **Product size: 345 bp**

The 345 bp product is specific for the *hi1207Tg* mutant genomic DNA. No PCR product is generated for wild-type genomic DNA.
